PEF Grants Program



Applications now available!

The PEF Grants Program is the signature program of the Peabody Education Foundation. Every fall the PEF offers funding to teachers and schools to provide their classrooms and students with programs and resources that fall outside of the normal school budget.

Applications are submitted to the PEF Grants Committee for consideration and approval. Funding is provided through the generous donations of our community and local businesses. Since 1985, the Peabody Education Foundation has worked endlessly to raise over \$1M from within the community to bring innovative programs to our public schools!

There are now two opportunities for funding:

Individual Teacher Grants: Teachers are welcome to submit individual grants for their classroom with a \$1500 cap limit. Applications are currently being accepted and will continue to be accepted and reviewed on a rolling-basis **until February 1, 2023**. Funding is available on a first-come, first-served basis.

School-wide Grants: Principals/Department Heads are welcome to submit grants that benefit entire grades or schools with a \$10,000 cap limit. Applications are currently being accepted and will continue to be accepted and reviewed on a rolling-basis **until February 1, 2023**. Funding is available on a first-come, first-served basis.

Birthday Books Program



Happy Birthday, students!

Many children from within our City come from homes where books are not readily available. The goal of the Birthday Books Program is to help children and families see books as valuable treasures and treats that can be enjoyed as presents and shared with the entire family. The Birthday Books Program hopes to foster a love of reading and books, promote family time together and help families to realize the importance of having books in the home to read again and again.

In 2021, the PEF teamed up with JB Thomas-Lahey Foundation to fund the Birthday Books Program for every elementary school student in Peabody! And because of the generous funding from our sponsors, the Birthday Books Program is now a permanent part of the Peabody Education Foundation's commitment to our children! Every year, every elementary student will be able to bring home that special birthday book!

Books are distributed by each elementary school to their own students with a Happy Birthday sticker included inside each book. Over 3000 students are now able to take their own birthday book home and share it with their family!

Guest Reader Program



Reading to our students is key!

The Guest Reader Program is for students in kindergarten through grade 5. Every year, from January to May, business leaders and local community members spend 20 to 30 minutes per week in an elementary school classroom reading aloud to the children. The Program is intended to expose students to the pleasures of reading and to present a positive reading role model. Reading to children brings enjoyment to both the readers and the students, and reinforces the idea that reading is fun for everyone.
