PEF Grants Program



\$90K Awarded This Past Year; 2025–2026 PEF Grant Applications Open in August

During the 2024-2025 school year, the Peabody Education Foundation funded nearly \$90,000 in PEF Grants. We received more than eighty applications from across the Peabody school district.

The PEF Grants were used to fund classroom materials and resources such as Scholastic News Magazines, NoRedInk Writing, and Everyday Speech; field trips to places like the North Shore Music Theater, the Boston Tea Party Museum, and Salem Sound Coastwatch; and in-



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school programs such as the traveling S.T.E.A.M. Museum and a Haitian dance group.

The application process for the 2025-2026 school year will open in early August.

Science From Scientists



Exploratory Science Program for 4th & 5th Graders

The PEF funded this district-wide program for 4th and 5th grade students across all seven elementary schools. This yearlong program, conducted by the SciSci staff in collaboration with classroom teachers, offered an experiential approach to science through hands-on, exploratory learning.

Students met weekly in a social setting to engage in exciting science activities, promoting both STEM learning and mental wellness through collaboration and teamwork. We provided \$80,000 to run this program, which impacted over 400 fourth-grade students across the district!

Career Day

In April, the Peabody Education Foundation once again hosted Career Day at PVMHS, with 56 vendors and local businesses participating. Career Day allows students to explore the various trades and career paths represented and interact with the representatives of those occupations.
